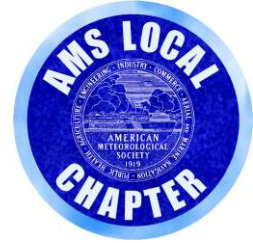

- Let Sara know if you want to help with any of these outreach events!

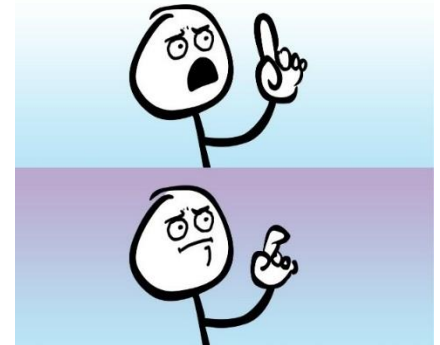
Academic Chair – Jon Thielen
