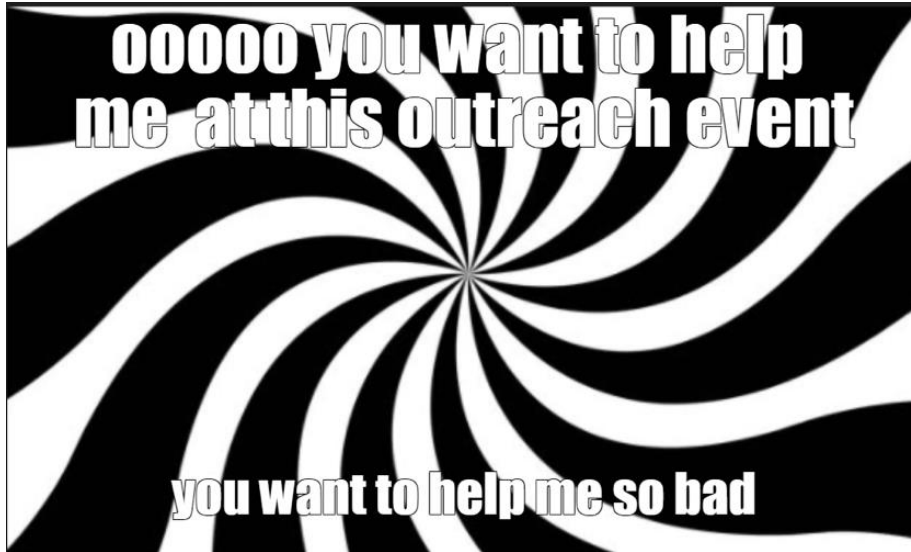

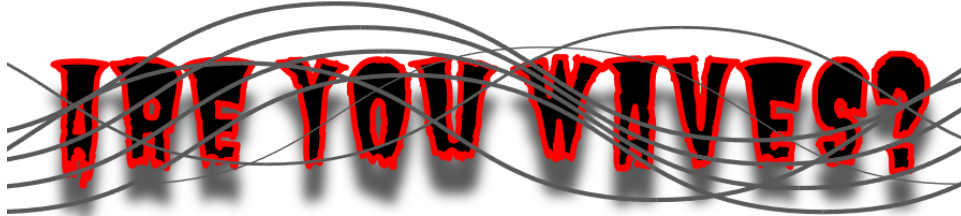

  - If any person is running unopposed for a position, they will not be asked to do a question and discussion session for the sake of time.
  - As President, I will be abstaining from discussion to avoid bias, though I am willing to answer objective questions during the President election
