What is a scholarship???

 "A grant or payment made to support a student's education, awarded on the basis of academic or other achievement" – Google

Common types of scholarships

Merit-based scholarships

Athletic or Art based scholarships

Minority/demographic scholarships

Military scholarships

Government scholarships (FAFSA)

Fellowships (scholarship lasting a few weeks/years, usually to support research/graduate school)

No essay scholarships (be careful)

Why should I apply?



Financial plus



Could look great on resume depending on the scholarship



An opportunity to improve your writing skills



Additional funding/benefits may be included

Legitimate scholarships will usually ask for...

Demographic information (personal background)

Current unofficial/official transcript

Resume or CV (Curriculum Vitae)


A personal statement(s)

- What makes you qualified to earn this scholarship?
- What are your career/educational goals and how will this scholarship assist in achieving these goals?

0-2 letters of recommendation (3 in some instances)

Usually has eligibility requirements

Applications take time... sorry.



NO ESSAY scholarships will usually ask for...

- Name
- Contact info (email, phone #)
- A very short response (a few sentences, up to 250 characters (~50 words))
- May have eligibility requirements
- Sometimes referred to as a "sweepstakes" scholarship

When can lapply?
